



THREE IN ONE?








Communication of the parts

- -Man is spirit AND soul AND body.
- -Your soul "communicates" with your body and your spirit.
- -In an **unregenerated** state, your spirit is controlled by your body and various spirits. In a **regenerated state**, your soul is controlled by your spirit's relationship with God's Spirit (the Holy Spirit).
- -The **natural** life is the battle for your soul; the **supernatural** life is one of moral victory over your soul and the empowerment possible because of the spirit/Holy Spirit relationship.

Man is Spirit and Soul and Body

The word of God treats man as tripartite – 3 parts



Creation

Gen 1:27:-.God created man in **His own image** (NKJV)....


Ps 39:13,14- For you created my **inmost being** (NIV)formed my **inward parts** (NKJV). I am fearfully and wonderfully made... marvelous are your works and that my **soul** knows very well (NKJV)

John 3:6 "...that which is born of the flesh is flesh, and **that which** is born of the Spirit is spirit.

The soul is created/revived when God (the Holy Spirit) breathes life into the body.


Genesis 2:7 – Man formed then made alive


The spirit is life

Job 32:8- ... it is the spirit (your personal spirit) in a mortal, the breath of the Almighty, that makes human insight (your soul) possible.

Ecc 12:7- The body is put back in the same ground it came from. The spirit (your personal spirit) returns to God, who first breathed it.

Functions of the 3 parts



soul and personal spirit / God relationship

Luke 1:46-(Mary)- *My soul* magnifies the Lord, and *my spirit* has rejoiced in God my savior (NKJV).

The soul knows when the spirit is in **healthy** relationship with God.

The soul is always conscious of the body, healthy or not.

This suggests that **your personal spirit must be awakened or reborn** for a healthy relationship with God. We'll see this now when we discuss personal spirit function and dysfunction.



Compromised soul

- -Yielding to temptation or attention to other spirits will change the balance.
- -Your soul is compromised by yielding to body temptation.
- -Your personal spirit becomes dysfunctional when corrupted by other spirits or by a compromised soul.

Personal Spirit Dysfunction



"Other" Spirits

- We are also spirits. We live in a spiritual world.
- Other spirits can influence our personal spirits.
- Some spirits are good, some are bad.
- **Bad**: Spirits (demons) of materialism, hate, violence, confusion, abortion, pride, of corrupt people, etc. ...**name some**
- **Good or bad**: other people's spirits (family members, friends, neighbors, teachers); books and movies (contain the spirit of the author); internet; etc. ...name some
- Good: Holy Spirit; Godly men and women ...name some
- **Discernment :** effect of the Word and relationship with the Holy Spirit on your conscience and intuition (functions of your spirit)

GOD-spirit relationship

- **1. Corporate worship** (worshipping in spirit and truth *OR* can't get into it, feel left out of it.) John 4:23,4- *Your worship must engage* your spirit in the pursuit of truth...true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth.
- 2. Satisfying private devotions (entering His presence easily *OR* hard to comprehend or invest time in bible study.) Isa 40:31- *Yet those who wait for the LORD will gain new strength; they will mount up with wings like eagles.* Num 14:24 "...my servant Caleb...has a different spirit; he follows me passionately. ALSO 1Cor 14:14- If *I pray in tongues, my spirit prays.*

GOD-spirit relationship

3. Your ability to hear God – (intuitive hunches and revelations *OR* never happens to you, clueless.) Psa 85:8- Let me hear what God the LORD will speak, for he will speak peace to his people, to his faithful, to those who turn to him in their hearts. Luk_8:21- But he said to them, "My mother and my brothers are those who hear the word of God and do it." 1Sam 3:10-Samuel answered, "Speak, for your servant hears." **4. Inspiration** – (creativity, Holy Spirit infusion of ideas, visions *OR* never creative, need instructions.) Intuition, rhema word, visions, dreams, subconscious revelation, creativity.

GOD-spirit relationship

5. Protection from disease - (never ill or throw off illness quickly *OR* always ill and long to recuperate) Pro 17:22- *A joyful heart is good medicine, but a broken spirit dries up the bones* Pro 18:14- A healthy spirit conquers adversity, but what can you do when the spirit is crushed?

Jesus understood this: "...your faith (your trust and confidence that spring from your belief in God) has restored you to health."(Luke 17:19, AMP). **Restoration is possible.**

Personal spirit consciousness

- 6. **Transcend time** (understanding time and consequence, being responsible, seeing the big picture *OR* always late in payments and appointments, slow in or not committing to Christ.)
- 7. **A Good conscience** (works before the event to keep you out of trouble *OR* works only after the event to make you aware of sin; and repentance *vs.* remorse.)

Good conscience

- A good conscience is a moral conscience, not one easily changed by ethical or other philosophical considerations. The state of your conscience affects others as well as yourself.
- -Phil 2:4- do not merely look out for your own personal interests, but also for the interests of others.
- -1Pe 3:16- Keep a clear conscience before God so that when people throw mud at you, none of it will stick.

Repentance and Remorse

Rom 6:15- So, since we're out from under the old tyranny, does that mean we can live any old way we want? Since we're free in the freedom of God, can we do anything that comes to mind? Hardly. (MSG) Pierre: "Hell no!"

- **Morality** (God consciousness) not ethics or law (world consciousness) nor personal gratification should be the compass for your conscience.
- Once conscience is challenged to change, repentance and resolve (will power) are the keys.
- **Remorse** (I'm sorry I got caught; I can't change) *vs.* **Repentance** (I won't do it again; I can change)

Personal spirit relationships

8. **Communication with others** - (easy relationships with others, social and listening skills, easy and productive conversations *OR* hard to talk with, loner)

Personal spirit relationships

9. **Bonding with the opposite sex** - (in marriage *OR* outside of marriage) **ISSUES related to sex:**

Marital consummation – bonding for co-creation / for family / healthy spirit

Pre-marital consummation - self-gratification / lust Adultery - bonding impaired / transferred / damaged spirit

Promiscuity – depravity, STD's / near dead spirit

Homosexuality – unnatural desires / ignorant spirit Abortion – murder / against family / unhealthy spirit

9. **Bonding with the opposite sex -** the two shall become one flesh." (Mark 10:8)

If you understand the purposes of sex, its unique God-given nature to bond two spirits to co-create new beings, then **sex only in marriage** avoids a plethora of sins. We are led by society, movies, TV, to believe that such perversions as adultery, promiscuity, homosexuality, and abortion issues are ethical choices. And, they may be accepted, but they are not acceptable, not moral.

Jdg 17:6- *In those days ... all the people did what was right in their own eyes.* Is it different today?

6 P's of Lent:


- **Choice 1 Personal sacrifice** and **Purity (Fasting):** overcoming the wants of your body.
- **Choice 2-** *Prayer* and *Praise*: fine tuning your moral compass, acknowledging your weakness and His strength in this overcoming effort, help you to know God and His ways.
- **Consequence** more of His *Power* and *Presence* in your life, overcoming temptation, a renewed spirit.



Personal Spirit Dysfunction



Gal 5: 16-26 (MSG) Choose

(NOTE Spirit and spirit)

Gal 5:16 ... Live freely, animated and motivated by God's Spirit.

Then you won't feed the compulsions of selfishness.

For there is a root of sinful self-interest in us that is at odds with a free spirit, just as the free spirit is incompatible with selfishness.

These two ways of life are antithetical, so that you cannot live at times one way and at times another way according to how you feel on any given day.

Why don't you choose to be led by the Spirit and so escape the erratic compulsions of a law-dominated existence?

Gal 5: 16-26 (KJV) – Choose your own way

Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

Some of those words in red are not those we use in everyday English conversations. Let's make them perfectly clear.

Gal 5: 16-26 (AMP) – Choose your own way

they are immorality, impurity, indecency, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, anger (ill temper), selfishness, divisions (dissensions), party spirit (factions, sects with peculiar opinions, heresies), envy, drunkenness, carousing, and the like.

One more translation.....

Gal 5: 16-26 (MSG) – Choose your own way

It is obvious what kind of life develops out of trying to get your own way all the time: repetitive, loveless, cheap sex; a stinking accumulation of mental and emotional garbage; frenzied and joyless grabs for happiness; trinket gods; magic-show religion; paranoid loneliness; cutthroat competition; all-consuming-yet-never-satisfied wants; a brutal temper; an impotence to love or be loved; divided homes and divided lives; small-minded and lopsided pursuits; the vicious habit of depersonalizing everyone into a rival; uncontrolled and uncontrollable addictions; ugly parodies of community. I could go on. This isn't the first time I have warned you, you know. If you use your freedom this way, you will not inherit God's kingdom.

Choose God's Way - Abiding in Him Produces Fruit

John 15:4,5 Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it remains in the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me. I am the Vine, you are the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, the same brings forth much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing.

What kind of fruit?

Gal 5: 16-26 (MSG) Choose God's way - Fruit of the Spirit

But what happens when we live God's way? He brings gifts into our lives, much the same way that fruit appears in an orchard--things like affection for others (love), exuberance about life (joy), serenity (peace). We develop a willingness to stick with things (patience), a sense of compassion in the heart (kindness), and a conviction that a basic holiness permeates things and people (goodness). We find ourselves involved in loyal commitments (faithfulness), not needing to force our way in life (gentleness), able to marshal and direct our energies wisely (self-control).

Legalism (set of rules) is helpless in bringing this about; it only gets in the way.

Gal 5: 16-26 (MSG) Now work it out!

Among those who belong to Christ, everything connected with getting our own way and mindlessly responding to what everyone else calls necessities is killed off for good--crucified.


Since this is the kind of life we have chosen, the life of the Spirit, let us make sure that we do not just hold it as an idea in our heads or a sentiment in our hearts, but work out its implications in every detail of our lives. That means we will not compare ourselves with each other as if one of us were better and another worse. We have far more interesting things to do with our lives. Each of us is an original.

My Way vs. God's Way

Doing it MY way

- a root of sinful self-interest that is at odds with a free spirit.
 - mindlessly responding to what the world calls necessities **Doing it GOD'S way**
 - the life of the Spirit in you produces the fruit of the Spirit
 - working out its implications in every detail of our lives
- The workings of the Holy Spirit can deliver people from the tyranny of self life with its carnality, and from the domination of the passions and lusts of the flesh. Choose to be led by the Holy Spirit to escape the erratic compulsions of a law-dominated existence.

The other is Good. It is joy, peace, love, hope, humility, kindness, empathy and truth."


The boy thought about it and asked: "Grandfather, which wolf wins?" The old man quietly replied: "The one you feed."



Examples of Learned Behavioral Actions

Are you doing this? Why?

Graffiti / littering – who is affected? Texting while driving (with family in the car?) Not using seatbelts, child seats or helmets (car, bike, 4-wheel, etc) Doing 65 in 55 mph zone, 83 in 70

These are not victimless decisions.

Examples of Learned Behavioral Actions

Are you doing this? Why?

Overeating, inebriation and addictions
Pornographic TV, internet, or R & X movies
Making choices for your children: T or M, PG-13 or R
What is license vs. freedom? Do you have a moral compass?
Are you different when alone than when with others?

What effect on you and your family?

Everyone's doing it....

- What's wrong with saying: "everyone is doing it" OR "it's OK because I am not affected by it?"
- How about: "It's easier to say you're sorry afterwards than to get permission first." No...it usually just gets easier to develop a habit of *not* getting it right, and then *not* saying you are sorry for it.
- The conflict in life is waged over turning our natural life into a spiritual life. This is never done easily, nor does God intend it to be. It is accomplished only through a series of moral choices. These choices are continually opposed and hostile to the things of our natural life which have become so deeply entrenched in us. You have to work at it!

Godly Character / Behavior Modification

Doing the right thing,

-Even if it costs you.



Genetics and environment

- "Who you are" is shaped by genetics and environment.
- Genetics dictates much of your body (what you are born with color of your skin/hair/eyes; your height, etc.), but you have choices for your physical and spiritual environment (what you live with **and** choose to live with what you read, see, who you hang around with).
- Free will allows you the best environment, a moral one, the one based on the Word, and the workings of the Holy Spirit.
- I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing. Therefore, choose life, so that both you and your seed may live (Deu 30:19)
- Your personal spirit's functions of conscience, intuition and communion are the channels for this new life, new environment.

Genetics

Original sin – our genetic spiritual inheritance

In the Garden of Eden, Man chose to transgress God's command, step out of His Lordship, separate himself from God and become a subject of satan.

This is what we are born with – our genetic inheritance. Our personal spirit, unless redeemed, is out of touch with God. John 8:47 *He who is of God hears God's Words... you do not hear them because you are not of God.*

John 3:3 (KJV) Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.


Personal Spirit Redeemed

Solution:

John 1:4 In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. John 8:35-6 ...the Son abides forever. Therefore if the Son shall make you free, you shall be free indeed.





- And these things will come in like a flood, unless we allow the Holy Spirit to raise up the banner against it.






The Spiritual Man and Maturity

7A

Holy Spirit → man's spirit

• 1 Cor 2:14 ...the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him; nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned.



The Spiritual Man

1Cor 2:15 But he who is spiritual judges all things, yet he himself is judged by no one (NKJV).

It takes time to reach the stage described by I Corinthians 2:15 as he that is spiritual.

Just as physical development takes time, so spiritual development also takes time. No one is spiritual the day he is born again. It takes time to become spiritual.

A key concept in spirituality is maturity.

Maturity

Just as it can be used in the physical sense and in the emotional sense, maturity can also be used in the spiritual sense.

All of us are born physically as babies, and in the course of time, we mature to adulthood. By the same token, all of us are born again as "spiritual babes" or spiritually immature, and it takes time to reach spiritual maturity.

Some people never develop to physical or emotional maturity. Things could also happen to keep a believer from developing to spiritual maturity, but the key concept is maturity.

"Spirituality is a grown-up relationship to the Holy Spirit" (Ryrie).

Maturing in the Holy Spirit 1

First, a new believer cannot be called "spiritual" because he has not, as yet, had enough time to grow and develop in spiritual knowledge and experience.

A **second** point is that an older believer may not be spiritually mature because, while he has had the time, he has not allowed the Holy Spirit to control him.

Maturing in the Holy Spirit 2

Third, there are stages of growth. Just as in the physical realm there are stages of growth, there are also stages of growth in the spiritual realm. It is a growing grown-up relationship to the Holy Spirit.

For that reason, a new believer must not be placed in a leadership position in the local church (I Tim. 3:6). Maturity or spirituality cannot be achieved by a sudden, emotional, or an ecstatic experience. Even so, there is always room for further growth and development (I Cor. 13:12; Phil. 3:12-14).

Maturing in the Holy Spirit 3

The *fourth* point is that spiritual life is composed of many areas. It involves your personality, your behavior in family life, your church life, your employment life, and your national life.


The *fifth* point is that although we are born again as spiritual babes, babyhood need not last long.

In I Corinthians 3:13, we see that Paul expected his readers to have been mature by the time he wrote that letter. Between his evangelization of Corinth and the writing of the Book of I Corinthians, there was a period of four to five years.

Wages – what you earn by your efforts, or lack of efforts.


Rom 6:23 – The wages of sin in **death.**

There is no life in death.

Romans 6:20-21 (MSG)

As long as you did what you felt like doing, ignoring God, you didn't have to bother with right thinking or right living, or right anything for that matter. But do you call that a free life? What did you get out of it? Nothing you're proud of now. Where did it get you? A dead end.

Dead Spirit – little or no Holy Spirit access



BUT - Romans 8:11 (MSG)

It stands to reason, doesn't it, that if the alive-and-present God who raised Jesus from the dead moves into your life, he'll do the same thing in you that he did in Jesus, bringing you alive to himself? When God lives and breathes in you (and he

Rom 8:12 - ...the law of the Spirit of Christ Jesus has set you free from the law of sin and death





The Holy Spirit With, In, and Upon Us

With, In, Filled With, On and Upon Us:

The purpose of the Holy Spirit baptism is to be clothed with more power from heaven so that we can be more effective witnesses for Jesus Christ.

Prior to asking for forgiveness and receiving the Lord as our Savior, we have the Holy Spirit *with* us, drawing us to Christ.

We received the Holy Spirit <u>in</u> us when we first believed, repented and received Jesus Christ **as Savior**. At that time, we were born again by the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit Baptism – 3rd work of Grace


The baptism of the Holy Spirit is in addition to, and separate from, this initial new birth experience.

The baptism of the Holy Spirit comes when the Holy Spirit comes **upon** (OR **on**; also **filled with**) a believer who professes Jesus **as Lord** and asks Him for this gift.

It is a free gift, like salvation, yours for the asking.

Holy Spirit Baptized = When you're beyond confessing, when your behavior says "Jesus is Lord" and is controlled by the Holy Spirit.

How He Came 1

John 14:16,17 "I will ask the Father, and He will give you another Helper, that He may be with you forever; that is the Spirit of truth, whom the world cannot receive, because it does not see Him or know Him, but you know Him because He abides with you and will be in you."

Acts 8:14-17 Now when the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent them Peter and John, who came down and prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit. For He had not yet fallen **upon** any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. Then they began laying their hands on them, and they were receiving the Holy Spirit.

How He Came 2

Acts 10:44-46 While Peter was still speaking these words, the Holy Spirit fell **upon** all those who were listening to the message. All the circumcised believers who came with Peter were amazed, because the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out **on** the Gentiles also. For they were hearing them <u>speaking with tongues</u> and <u>exalting</u> <u>God.</u>

Acts 19:5-6 When they heard this, they were baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus. And when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Spirit came on them, and they began speaking with tongues and prophesying.



If you want it, ask for it!

Asking for the Baptism

Father, I'm tired of being a spectator, I want to be a player. I'm ready to be a functioning member of your body.

I want to be more than a sponge. I'm tired of "sitting on my blessed assurances." Help me get out of my church seat and serve you through the overflow of the Holy Spirit.

Overtake me. Change me. Anoint me to your service. "Here I am, send me!"

Laying on of Hands

...they (Peter and John) began laying their hands on them, and they were receiving the Holy Spirit. Acts 8:17

...and when Paul had laid his hands upon them, the Holy Spirit came on them... Acts 19:6

"Laying on of hands" = a common method for Holy Spirit baptism







Armor of God – Getting ready for battle

Belt of Truth – truth accepted in your inner parts, an obedient heart, know who the enemy is and how he operates. Know whose side you're on.

Breastplate of Righteousness – mind, conscience is covered with right living.

Feet shod with Gospel of Peace – ready to move, read the book for instruction and nourishment.

Shield of Faith – a strong and lively faith the quenches the darts of the enemy. Helmet of Salvation – protect your mind with the assurance of victory and the hope of salvation.

Sword of the Spirit – use the Word as an offensive weapon, "it is written". Pray in the Spirit at all times – keep in touch, Spirit-spirit communication. Having done all...STAND. Stand guard, be ready, stand with Joy, surmount difficulties, hold out to the end. No retreat. Call in reinforcement.

Wrong Living

- Eph 4:19: So I tell you this, and insist on it in the Lord, that you must no longer live as the Gentiles do, in the futility of their thinking. They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts. Having lost all sensitivity, they have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity, with a continual lust for more.
- wrong thinking -> lose understanding -> become separated from God -> heart is hardened -> become ruled by your senses -> never enough -> hooked

Right Living starts with Right Thinking

1Co 2:14- The unspiritual self, just as it is by nature, can't receive the gifts of God's Spirit. There's no capacity for them. They seem like so much silliness. Spirit can be known only by spirit--God's Spirit and our spirits in open communion.

Remember, you were...created to be like God in true righteousness (right living) and holiness (set apart for Him) (Eph 4:24).

Don't mess with the plan.

Living as Children of Light 1

KJV - Wherefore I give you to understand...that no man can say that Jesus is the Lord, but by the Holy Ghost.

MSG... by using your heads, you know perfectly well that the Spirit of God would never prompt anyone ...to say "Jesus is Master!" without the insight of the Holy Spirit.

NASB Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God says..."Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit.

AMP Therefore I want you to understand that no one speaking under the power and influence of the [Holy] Spirit of God can [ever] ... [really] say, Jesus is [my] Lord, except by and under the power and influence of the Holy Spirit.

Who gets the gifts? 1Cor 12:11

But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing **to each one** individually just **as He wills**.

Gifts are given to those led by the Holy Spirit. "His Gifts, His choice" **not** "our gifts, our choice." For the common benefit of the body of Christ.

Principles - The Gifts of the Spirit

- 1. Recognition of Jesus as Lord is inspired by the Holy Spirit and is the prerequisite for spiritual gifts
- 2. Spiritual gifts, although different one from another, are from the same Holy Spirit
- 3. All spiritual gifts are given for the common benefit of the body of Christ

The Seven Service Gifts of the Spirit – Rom 12:6-8

We **have** different gifts, according to the grace given us. If a man's gift is **prophesying**, let him use it in proportion to his faith.

If it is **serving**, let him serve;

if it is teaching, let him teach; if it is encouraging, let him encourage; if it is contributing to the needs of others, let him give generously; if it is leadership, let him govern diligently;

if it is showing mercy, let him do it cheerfully. (NIV)

Everyone has a role to play. Which are you?

The Five Leadership Gifts (Eph 4:11)

And truly He gave some to be apostles, and some to be prophets, and some to be evangelists, and some to be pastors and teachers,...

Five-fold Leadership Gifts

- **Apostles** start new churches, form new congregations, organize and authorize (bishops)
- **Prophets-** bring new revelation; advance the kingdom, correct misinterpretation, warn of God's wrath
- **Evangelists-** spread the gospel, recruit more members, save the lost **Pastors-** teach the Word, disciple the members of the body, comfort the spiritually oppressed, "feed the sheep"
- **Teachers-** help you understand the Word and your function in the Kingdom

Why The Five Leadership Gifts (Eph 4:12-16)?

Eph 4:12 ... for the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ. 13 And this until we all come into the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to a full-grown man, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ; 14 so that we no longer may be infants, tossed to and fro and carried about by every wind of doctrine, in the dishonesty of men, in cunning craftiness, to the wiles of deceit. 15 But that you, speaking the truth in love, may in all things grow up to Him who is the Head, even Christ; 16 from whom the whole body, fitted together and compacted by that which every joint supplies, according to the effectual working in the measure of each part, producing the growth of the body to the edifying of itself in love.

Equip the people for ministry (12)

Build up the church (12)

Unify the church around knowing Christ (12)

Bring us to maturity (13)

Bring us to fullness (13)

Keep us from error (14-5)

Help us to grow (15)

Release a supply of all the church needs (16)

Cause the church to increase its ministry(16)

The only conclusion from an honest study of these scriptures is that gifted leaders are indispensable to the church.

Tongues and Prayer Language

Tongues – a supernatural utterance in a language not known to the speaker, either **earthly** (literally speaking another human language not learned) or **heavenly** (a language consisting of non-human words).

1 Cor 14:2-4

1Co 14:2-4 ... for he who speaks in a tongue (prayer language) does not speak to men but to God. For no one hears, but in spirit he speaks mysteries. But he who prophesies (speaking in tongues) speaks to men for building up, and exhortation, and comfort.

The one speaking in a tongue (prayer language) builds himself up, but he prophesying (speaking in tongues) builds up a church.

Prayer language

It does not need to be interpreted, for it is directly edifying the one praying, because it is intercession by inspiration of the Holy Spirit .

Rom 8:26 Likewise the Spirit also helps our infirmities. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

1Co 14:2 For he who speaks in a tongue does not speak to men but to God. For no one hears, but in spirit he speaks mysteries.

Kinds of Tongues

One of the nine supernatural gifts of the Holy Spirit.
Used to edify and build up the church, when it is accompanied by the **interpretation of tongues**, another of the nine, which is the ability given by the Holy Spirit to hear an unknown language and to understand it.

1Co 14:5,6 Now I wish that you all spoke in tongues, but even more that you would prophesy; and greater is one who prophesies than one who speaks in tongues, unless he interprets, so that the church may receive edifying. But now, brethren, if I come to you speaking in tongues, what will I profit you unless I speak to you either by way of revelation or of knowledge or of prophecy or of teaching? (NASB)

Faith vs. Works

Faith vs. works:

BE-ing (God's way) *trumps* **DO**-ing (my way); you have to **BE** first;

you are doing good works because you are a **BE**-ing; you won't become a **BE**-ing because you are doing good works.

Holy Spirit- personal spirit relationship produces God's work; my work doesn't sway God into a relationship. You can't buy your way in with self-guided work.

Patience: a willingness to stick with things


Kindness: a sense of compassion in the heart

Fruit of the Spirit

• Gal 5:22-3 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

• Gal 5:16-7 So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature. For the sinful nature desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the sinful nature.

Whose credentials?

Php 3:3,4- For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh. Though I might also have confidence in the flesh. (KLV)

Php 3:3,4- The real believers are the ones the Spirit of God leads to work away at this ministry, filling the air with Christ's praises as we do it. We couldn't carry this off by our own efforts, and we know it-- even though we can list what many might think are impressive credentials. (MSG)

 - mindlessly responding to what the world calls necessities **Doing it GOD'S way**
 - the life of the Spirit in you produces the fruit of the Spirit
 - working out its implications in every detail of our lives
- The workings of the Holy Spirit can deliver people from the tyranny of self life with its carnality, and from the domination of the passions and lusts of the flesh. Choose to be led by the Holy Spirit to escape the erratic compulsions of a law-dominated existence.

Gal 5: 16-26 (KJV) – Choose your own way

Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these: adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

Some of those words in red are not those we use in everyday English conversations. Let's make them perfectly clear.

Gal 5: 16-26 (AMP) – Choose your own way




Gal 5: 16-26 (MSG) – Choose your own way

I could go on. This isn't the first time I have warned you, you know. If you use your freedom this way, you will not inherit God's kingdom.

The Holy Spirit With, In, and Upon Us

With, In, Filled With, On and Upon Us:

The purpose of the Holy Spirit baptism is to be clothed with more power from heaven so that we can be more effective witnesses for Jesus Christ.

Prior to asking for forgiveness and receiving the Lord as our Savior, we have the Holy Spirit *with* us, drawing us to Christ.

We received the Holy Spirit <u>in</u> us when we first believed, repented and received Jesus Christ **as Savior**. At that time, we were born again by the Holy Spirit.

The Holy Spirit Baptism – 3rd work of Grace


The baptism of the Holy Spirit is in addition to, and separate from, this initial new birth experience.

The baptism of the Holy Spirit comes when the Holy Spirit comes **upon** (OR **on**; also **filled with**) a believer who professes Jesus **as Lord** and asks Him for this gift.

It is a free gift, like salvation, yours for the asking.

Holy Spirit Baptized = When you're beyond confessing, when your behavior says "Jesus is Lord" and is controlled by the Holy Spirit.

But to each one is given the showing forth of the Spirit to our profit. For through the Spirit is given to one a word of wisdom; and to another a word of knowledge, according to the same Spirit; and to another faith by the same Spirit; and to another the gifts of healing by the same Spirit;

and to another workings of powers, to another prophecy; and to another discerning of spirits; and to another kinds of tongues; and to another the interpretation of tongues.

But the one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing separately to each one as He desires. (NKJV)

1 Cor 12:8-11- The Supernatural Gifts of the Spirit

Giving Him Preeminence – Passion, Presence

- I will be with you always (Matt 28:19-21.
- Some people place high value on God's presence and others don't. The ones who do enjoy fellowship throughout their day with the Holy Spirit are extremely conscious of how He feels about their words, actions and attitudes. The thought of grieving Him brings great sorrow. It's their passion to give him preeminence in everything.
- That passion brings the believer into a supernatural life one with the constant activity of the Holy Spirit working through them.

Salvation for others – Positive, Passionate, and Persistence

This is how we bring the lost into an encounter with God:

- We learn to recognize His presence, cooperate with His passion for people, and invite them to receive salvation.
- By looking for chances to serve others (preaching, praying for people's needs, etc.), we give the Holy Spirit the opportunity to do what only He can do miracles.
- I don't see everyone I pray for healed. But there are many more healed than would be had I not prayed for anyone. Even if I pray for a dead person and they are not raised from the dead, I pray for the next dead person too. I don't quit.

Getting God into us - Presence

Fullness of the Holy Spirit = Holy Spirit Baptism = Spirit Led

Without the fullness of the Holy Spirit in and upon me, I do not give God a surrendered vessel to flow through. Salvation may have been the immediate goal, but the ultimate goal is the fullness of the Spirit in the believer.

The Anointing - Power

- The presence of God is to be realized in the anointing: God's covering us with His power-filled presence.
- Supernatural things happen when we walk in the anointing.
- The anointing is not for our own enjoyment. This wonderful presence is to be taken to the world.

- He is in me for my sake, but He's upon me for yours!

Passing the baton – Presence, Power

For us to become all that God intended us to be, we must remember that Jesus' life was a model of what mankind could become if we were in the right relationship with the Father.

Jesus came as the light of the world, and then passed the baton to us, announcing that we are the light of the world. He said we would do "greater works" than He did (John 14:12).

He then pulled the greatest surprise of all, saying, in effect: "Right now the Holy Spirit is with you, but He's going to be in you". Jesus who illustrates to us what is possible for those who are right with God, now says that His people are to be the tabernacle of God on planet earth.

The Holy Spirit Residence

Paul says: "do you not know that you are the temple of God?" (1Cor 3:16) and:

"you are a dwelling place of God." (Eph 2:22).


